- The Courtesy Bus is available for use by Members, their guests and visiting patrons attending Club Dubbo
- Pick up and drop off locations must be a residential address or holiday location (E.g. Motel, Caravan Park)
- The Courtesy Bus operates within city limits as described below and will not take passengers to other licensed venues, or pick-up from other licensed venues.
- The Courtesy Bus area of operation is:
 - West Dubbo Travelling no further than Kintyre Village on the Newell Highway, no further than Delroy Outlook Estate on Minore Road & no further than the Westview Caravan Park on Narromine Road.
 - North Dubbo No further than Purvis Lane
 - East Dubbo No further than Bunninyong Road, no further than South Bunninyong Road and not past the roundabout on Sheraton Road/Mitchell Highway near Bunnings
 - South Dubbo Not past the intersection where Macquarie St merges into Old Dubbo road
 - Every attempt will be made to follow our schedule, however please be advised that all pick up times are approximate. Please allow up to 30 minutes from your booked time.
 - Courtesy Bus availability and operating times are subject to the seasonal requirements of the club. Please check the club website or phone the club before booking
 - The Courtesy Bus can transport a total of 11 passengers at a time and under no circumstance are patrons permitted to travel while standing.
 - Offensive language, objectionable behaviour, smoking and the consumption of food or beverages is not permitted on the Courtesy Bus.
 - The driver may refuse or eject any person if they believe the person is intoxicated, unruly or disruptive to the comfort of other passengers. The driver's decision is final in this regard and drivers have been have been instructed to drive to the nearest police station if there is any concern for their own, or passengers' safety or welfare

- In accordance with NSW child restraint laws, children 7 years and younger are not permitted on the Courtesy Bus.
- Persons under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- The Club may result to disciplinary action with any breach of these terms and conditions in accordance with the Clubs constitution.
